# Submission to Proposal for Establishment of Gravel Extraction by C.J. Industries on Peach Island.

In respect of the proposal for C.J. Industries to establish a gravel extraction quarry on Peach Island, I wish to submit my strong objection.

I reject the Applicant's statements that the proposed quarrying activities will only have a minor effect on the environment or on affected persons and that any adverse effects can be mitigated, implying that the works would not be in breach of the TRMP, Resource Management Act 1991, NPS for Freshwater Management 2014, and the Motueka River WCO. The combined adverse effects as outlined below, would severely impact on our quality of life, the environmental and rural amenity values of this outstanding river valley and the safety of travel on the effected road systems.

I recommend that the Application be declined in its totality.

Peach Island is a peaceful rural landscape with large areas of horticultural crops, animals grazing and open farm paddocks plus large areas of native bush. It is a beautiful landscape and a popular national cycleway. It is rural 1 land for good reason, with rich soils which allow horticultural crops to flourish.

The Motueka Valley is a valuable asset for the entire Motueka community. Motueka residents use the river for all sorts of recreational activities and it should be protected for all the community to continue to enjoy. A water Conservation Order was made on the Motueka River in 2004 because of the outstanding recreational characteristics, outstanding fisheries and wildlife habitat features, outstanding scientific values and outstanding wild and

scenic characteristics. It would be a terrible decision to allow a gravel quarry in this beautiful landscape.

The residents along both sides of the Motueka River bought their properties in good faith and put their heart and soul into their properties, knowing they look out on rural 1 land. They have dedicated their lives and incomes into planting orchards, growing successful businesses and created beautiful landscapes. For their efforts to be compromised by the introduction of industrial-scale quarrying is a travesty, an injustice on a massive scale.

#### MONITORING

CJ Industries suggest that if there are noise problems, we are to go to them. This is ridiculous, as residents we would need to have a noise complaints procedure that would be effective. This should be paid for by CJ Industries.

Truck movements, dust and water monitoring needs to be undertaken regularly. The applicant should pay for this. Watching the way the Douglas Road site has been managed, gives me no confidence that the applicant would adhere to the rules.

Peach Island has flooded numerous times in the past 30 years, the last time was July 2021. Given the obvious climatic impacts of Global Warming/climate change we believe that historical data cannot be relied upon to assess flood hazards. Heavy flood events are increasing in frequency and severity, exacerbated by silt loading due to disturbance, particularly in the Separation Point Granite zone. See photos below.





Photo 1 shows the river from our farm. The west bank channel is flooded. This is where stage 1 of the proposed gravel extraction will be. The river rises really fast, its hard to see how the applicant would be able to clean up the site when the water rises at night, or on weekends.

Photo 2 shows downstream of our place at Woodlands corner. The west bank channel and the main channel come together.




The Motueka River valley is a rich horticultural area and is enjoyed by all residents. Imagine when a southerly is blowing just upstream from this photo. The dust from the proposed site will hurt the crops and cause health problems for residents. The noise will ruin the peaceful valley feeling and cyclists on the national cycleway will have to deal with 30 truck and trailer movements on the west and east bank road.

### Peach Island is the wrong place to have a gravel quarry.

The TDC have a duty to protect the residents and the special areas of Tasman Bay and therefore must not allow this resource consent to proceed.

# IN THE MATTER OF CJ INDUSTRIES LIMITED PUBLICLY NOTIFIED RESOURCE CONSENT APPLICATION FOR GRAVEL EXTRACTION AT PEACH ISLAND, MOTUEKA.

#### **APPENDIX 'A'**

#### **PREAMBLE**

I am not a trade competitor of C J Industries Limited ('CJI') for the purposes of Section 308B of the Resource Management Act 1991 ('RMA').

I request, pursuant to Section 100A of the RMA, that TDC delegate its functions, powers and duties to hear and decide this application to a panel of hearing commissioners comprising Councillors representing the Motueka Ward and Motueka Community Board members, in order to retain decision making and accountability within the affected district.

I am directly affected by multiple effects of the subject matter of the CJI Application as follows:

#### TRANSPORT, ACCESS, HEAVY VEHICLE & TRAFFIC EFFECTS

Notwithstanding the designation of the Motueka Valley West Bank Road as a collector road there are several factors which limit the capacity of this road and consequently the safety of other road users:

- The road forms part of the National Cycle Way and is therefore not compatible, mutually exclusive even, with increased heavy vehicle activity.
- The road is already subject to use by heavy vehicles including logging trucks, milk tankers, rural cartage contractors etc.
- The proposed route to CJI's processing yard at Hau Road, Motueka is narrow, has many tight bends with restricted visibility, and 3 one lane bridges. All features which represent significant hazards to other road users.

That CJI has proposed a circuitous route to its Hau Road processing site via Alexander Bluff Bridge and the Motueka Valley Highway rather than a more direct route through Brooklyn, SH 60 and the Motueka CBD is tantamount to an admission that the proposed heavy vehicle movements will have adverse environmental and safety impacts on affected persons and businesses. Dust and noise nuisance would have been major issues for orchards, vineyards, residences, Brooklyn School and the Motueka CBD. However it seems that equally impacted residents and businesses along the proposed truck route, albeit at lower population densities, deserve less consideration.

#### **STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AND FLOOD EFFECTS**

Gravel extraction activities, by their very nature, involve the removal of topsoil/overburden, the excavation of compacted gravels and the stockpiling of extracted material and inward back fill. The unarguable impacts of Global Warming/Climate Change include more frequent and more severe rainfall events. The reliance on historical flood data (Q20, Q50 events etc.) as predictors of the risks of site inundation is now problematic. Virtually the entire Peach Island site falls within the Motueka

River flood plain. For CJI to imply that any sediment entering the river, inter alia '.....will not be discernible relative to the naturally elevated sediment concentrations' is an extraordinary mitigation claim. The 'naturally elevated sediment concentrations' are nothing of the sort as they are almost entirely due to man-made land disturbance related to exotic forestry harvesting, roading and associated earthworks in the highly unstable Separation Point Granite geological zone. Mitigating claims that erosion and slope failures have also occurred in native bush catchments are misleading to a quantum degree. CJI state that excavations within the berm land adjacent to the river could be exposed for up to six months before being back filled.

TDC is fully aware of research papers published by Cawthron Institute, by Landcare Research and by NIWA concerning land erosion and slope failures in the Motueka River and neighbouring catchments, and the consequent adverse environmental impacts of silt deposits and suspended sediments both within the river system and over extensive areas of Tasman Bay. Siltation of the benthic zone in Tasman Bay is now accepted as the primary cause of the collapse of the once iconic scallop fishery. The Motueka River Integrated Catchment Management study establishes that localised degradation at specific sites can have adverse impacts throughout the river and marine environments.

In summary, <u>any</u> activity which adds to the sediment load in the Motueka catchment and the marine environment is unacceptable.

CJI's reliance on flood warning systems giving adequate prior warning of impending land inundation creates a false sense of security. In the more realistic scenario of a flood event occurring from a sudden downpour of unexpected intensity there would be limited opportunity for CJI to enter the site to shift compromised plant and machinery, or perform remedial earthworks to stabilise stockpiles of loose material. These risks are compounded if such flood events were to occur at night, on weekends or during public holidays.

#### **DUST AND NOISE EFFECTS**

Dust will be a major environmental issue with the proposed quarrying activity - both that generated by site activities as created by extraction, transportation and stockpiling, and subsequently by onroad transportation. Any person familiar with logging trucks is aware of the collateral dust nuisance created by these trucks and the debris falling from the loads. As far as can be ascertained, CJI trucks will not be put through a vehicle wash before entering the public road system, and nor will the gravel or back fill loads be covered. Vehicle windscreen repairers can look forward to increased business.

Unequivocally the noise pollution from the site and associated transport activities will be invasive, particularly at locations where site noise combines with on-highway truck movements of up to 30 trips per day, or potentially one truck every 20 minutes. The acoustic characteristics of the valley are such that from elevated sites, the barking of dogs, small engine noise (e.g. chainsaws, lawnmowers etc.) and farm/orchard machinery are all clearly audible across the valley. CJI appear to have downplayed the scale and acoustic impacts of site activities when they refer to 'an excavator' and 'a dump truck' as being the predominant extraction/production equipment in use at any one time. In reality, it is more probable that multiple machines will be operating simultaneously in order to meet stated outputs. I speculate that a 20 or 25 tonne hydraulic excavator would be working in tandem with an off-road dump truck to extract the gravel then cart this for stockpiling; a wheeled loader would seem to be the most efficient machine to manage the gravel stockpiles, load the highway

truck and trailer units, process and mix the inwards back fill material and load an off road dump truck to transport the imported back fill to exposed pits.

Truck noise will be excessive where vehicles have to downshift to negotiate the 3 one lane bridges and tight corners – e.g. Woodmans Bend.

Waka Kotahi/NZ Transport Agency web site states that, in accordance with AS/NZS 2107:2000 recommendations, traffic noise should not exceed 45dBL inside dwellings where no acoustic treatment has been carried out (e.g. double glazing or ducted air conditioning). Valley residents are entitled to enjoy their rural lifestyles and use natural ventilation to cool their homes and facilitate our iconic indoor/outdoor lifestyle, particularly during summer months. Hegley Accoustic Consultants have stated that noise levels will not exceed 55dBL (per TRMP Rules) however this noise level exceeds Waka Kotahi guidelines. Consequences of intrusive environmental noise, as cited on the Ministry of Health web site include adverse impacts on health and wellbeing including cardiovascular disease. So we are dealing with actual adverse medical outcomes here, not just temporary inconvenience or nuisance.

It would seem that Hegley Accoustic Consultants have applied statistical analysis models that appear to average noise emissions throughout the working day, which obviously does not reflect actual peak noise volumes that will be experienced by persons, especially low frequency noise from diesel engines, ground engaging tools, impact noise from the dumping of material at stockpiles and the loading of trucks.

#### **VISUAL AMENITY EFFECTS**

From elevated properties in direct line of sight, the proposed quarry will be an eyesore. There is no such thing as a pretty gravel pit. Unsightly dust plumes will emanate from the site, especially during dry summer months when the daily downstream breeze kicks in, late morning or early afternoon.

#### SITE CONTAMINATIONOF SURFACE AND GROUNDWATER

The site geology mainly comprises compacted quaternary river gravels which have a high filtration rate but are also highly porous. CJI has outlined its response protocols for contaminant spills, but given the porosity of the site it will be problematic for CJI to effectively respond to and contain fuel spillages or mechanical failures such as hydraulic hose ruptures before such contaminants enter the groundwater system, with obvious risks to downstream household water bores. Furthermore a 'human element' must be factored when considering the composition of the back fill material. Leachate from decomposing organic matter will enter the groundwater and it would be naïve to believe that the stated 10% vegetation content will not be exceeded and/or contaminated refuse will not be dumped at the site despite CJI best intentions. 24/7 x 365 day site surveillance is not realistic.

#### **ECOLOGICAL AND BIODIVERSITY IMPACTS**

As outlined above, the lower Motueka River has been heavily degraded by the cumulative effects of streambed siltation. As a 'Citizen Scientist' I have observed this degradation for over 40 years by way of monitoring invertebrate fauna populations. I have observed that, of the once prolific

Ephemeroptera (mayfly) community, such species as Coloboriscus and Myzobranchia are now a rarity. Plecoptera (stonefly) populations have collapsed. Of the resilient Trichoptera genus the Aoteapsyche Colonica caddis have all but disappeared. Examples of the native kōura (Paranephrops Planifrons) are very rare. The viability of these apparently insignificant invertebrate populations may seem of little importance however we ignore planet Earth's shrinking biodiversity at our peril. I reiterate that any activity that causes further deterioration to the habitat of these animals should be deemed unacceptable.

CJI are essentially dismissive of the Motueka River Water Conservation Order 2004. Whilst the direct effect of the WCO may be limited to siltation of the river, the WCO is a living, aspirational document. The river has 'Wairua'. The WCO confers 'National Park' environmental protection status on the river in order to protect its outstanding cultural, recreational, scenic and amenity values. It would be intolerable for TDC to approve a resource consent for a similar gravel extraction operation adjacent to the boundary of any of our local National Parks – Abel Tasman, Nelson Lakes or Kahurangi. The WCO should not be viewed as an impediment to resource exploitation and development, its protections and intent able to be circumnavigated or marginalised in the interests of private commercial gain.

The CJI application makes no reference to having completed an assessment on the possible impacts on local fauna. The berm lands are known nesting, feeding, loafing and roosting sites for important bird species including waterfowl, terns, gulls, game birds and wading birds.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Throughout its application, CJI provides many assurances that any adverse environmental, traffic and amenity impacts of the proposed quarrying activities will be minor or can be mitigated, and thus compliant with the RMA and TRMP. Objective assessment of the proposed activities would indicate to the contrary on many counts, particularly as regards traffic safety, noise, dust and environmental impacts. No reasonable person should stand in the way of environmentally sustainable economic progress, or deny that high quality gravels are needed for civil engineering projects (particularly a new bridge on SH60 over the Motueka River) and for commercial/residential construction projects, however the proposed quarry at Peach Island has too many actual or potential risk factors to be approved by Council. The public good and the environment must take precedence over commercial activity in this instance.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend that the CJI Application be declined in its entirety.

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


