

Zone overview


- Four main waterbodies
 - Lower Takaka River
 - Takaka Gravel Aquifer
 - Lake Killarney
 - Te Kakau Stream
 - Estuary streams



Summary of Water Quality Issues

- No known issues in Takaka Gravel Aquifer
- Lower Takaka River
 - Catchment Sediment load and E.coli load
 - Wastewater treatment plant past issues resolved
- Lake Killarney urban inflows, phytoplankton
- Te Kakau Stream similar issues to Motupipi River (only worse)
 - Lack of flushing flows
 - Riparian habitat loss
 - causing temperature
 - causing excess light
 - impacts on biodiversity, aquatic habitat / ecological values
 - Nuisance plant growth (aquatic weed Lagarosiphon & algal blooms)
 - causing dissolved oxygen issues, potential to reduce clarity
 - exacerbated by lack of flushing flows, excess light, high temps and slightly elevated nutrients
