What is your PREFERENCE?

The Tasman District Council approved a "small projects" levy of \$5 per "rateable unit" for the Motueka Community Board to allocate, subject to consulting with Motueka residents and ratepayers.

This will raise \$25,000 for 3 – 5 projects in the Motueka Ward.

The Motueka Community Board is seeking the local Motueka response to the following projects.

Please mark 1, 2, 3, 4 in the relevant box as to your selections! (We want only your top 4 choices, please).

- Pram Crossings for Mobility Scooters – five in central areas of Motueka.
- Footpath extensions, or links e.g.
 - Martin's Farm Road, Kaiteriteri
 - Hickmott Place from Tudor Street
- Shared Footpath – Cycleway along Thorp Street, from Fearon Street to Staples Street.
- Shared Footpath – Cycleway along Staples Street, from Thorp Street to High Street / State Highway 60.
- Kerb and Channel along Hau Road (400 metres).
- Kerb and Channel along Hursthouse Street (300 metres) from Main Road, Lower Moutere.
- Litter Collection – jointly funded with Our Town Motueka and Keep Motueka Beautiful.
- Publish a cycling booklet on Motueka areas recreational, road, and mountainbike rides.
- Fund permanent raised bed materials for the Motueka Community Garden.
- Provide car-parking bays in the Whitwell's Car Park (subject to agreements with Property owners).
- Seal the Walkway – Cycleway between the Recreation Centre and Thorp's Bush Alongside the Woodlands Drain.
- A large mural (e.g. by the Golden Bay artists Chris Finlayson).
