Safe at the Top is a collaborative approach to improving community safety in Nelson/Tasman- using a tried and tested framework to align work, identify needs and gaps in provision and to maximise the resources available. The aim is to have Nelson / Tasman accredited as the 17<sup>th</sup> International Safer Community in New Zealand in 2011.

International Safe Communities is a World Health Organisation (WHO) concept that recognizes safety as "a universal concern and a responsibility for all". This approach to community safety encourages greater cooperation and collaboration between non-government organisations, the business sector, local and government agencies.

Accreditation is one step on the way to making our community safer.
