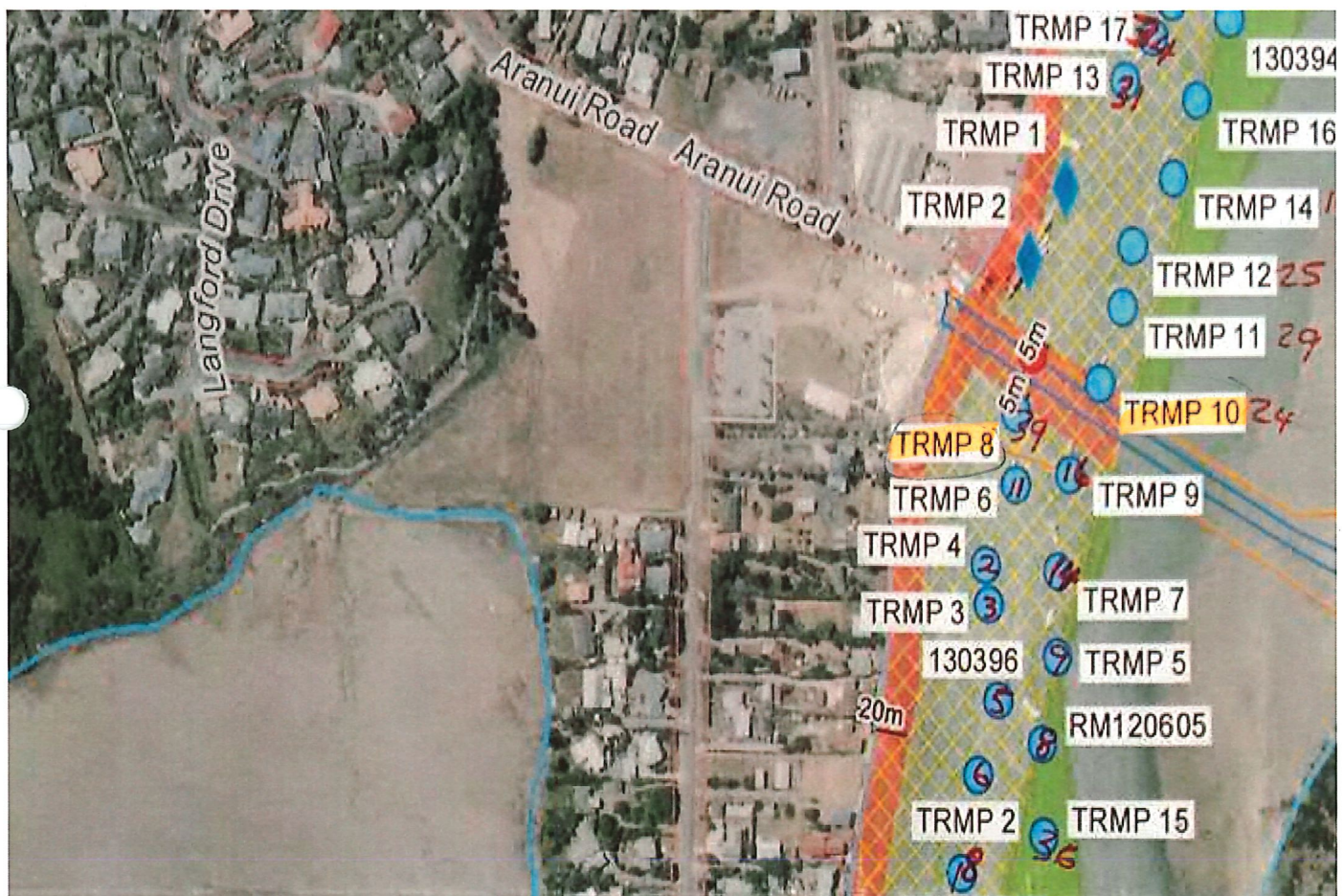
Hello Mark,

The 2 moorings in question are moorings TRMP 10 and TRMP 8, owned by Mike & Clare Kininmonth and Mapua Boat Club (respectively).

This issue has been raised in the RC to advise TDC that these moorings are located within a Waste Water Services corridor, that require relocating as indicated by TDC Waste Water Engineer, Jeff Cuthbertson.

In addition, previous discussions between Mapua Boat Club and TDC Harbourmaster (Dan Cairney) that TDC were intending to review the location of existing moorings to facilitate the relocation of moorings TRMP 10 and 8.
