DECISION

This is an application by DCH Limited for a Temporary Authority Order in respect of premises situated at 90 Commercial Street, Takaka, known as "Brigand Cafe Bar".

Reports were received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police and no matters in opposition were raised. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Section 136 of the Act.

Accordingly we grant an Order authorising the sale and supply of alcohol on the premises situated at **90 Commercial Street**, **Takaka** and known as "**Brigand Cafe Bar**" to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there, for three months from the date of this decision and authorise the issue of the Order.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136 of the Act obliging the holder of the Order to:

- 1. Ensure that the on-licence remains in force for the term of the Order.
- 2. Comply with the same duties, obligations and liabilities as required by the current on-licence.
- 3. Comply with the conditions of the Order.
