The omission was not on behalf of the applicant but has resulted from the Covid 19 lockdown. It appears the omission was not wilful but a matter of administrative oversight.

We waive the requirement relating to the prescribed time for the application to be lodged pursuant to Section 208 of the Act and grant the application for a renewal of a manager's certificate pursuant to s.228 of the Act. The certificate will expire on **2 May 2023** unless again renewed.
