### **DECISION**

This is an application by Jacquelyn Margaret Pestell for a renewal of a Manager's Certificate. Reports were received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police, and no matters in opposition were raised. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

The applicant holds the prescribed qualification required by s.218 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, and we are satisfied as to the other matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.227 of the Act.

It is noted that the applicant has little or no experience in the sale of alcohol from on-licence premises, so it is agreed between the applicant and the Tasman District Licensing Committee that the function of Manager will only be undertaken in off-licence premises. This limitation may be reviewed by the Tasman District Licensing Committee and removed as soon as suitable experience is obtained by the applicant.

This application for renewal was received after the expiry date of the certificate, however the applicant has provided an explanation of how this eventuated and asked that a Section 208 waiver be granted. The omission was not on behalf of the applicant but appears to have resulted from a clerical oversight by the Tasman District Council and the applicant not receiving the reminder for the renewal. It appears the omission was not wilful but a matter of administrative oversight. In such circumstances the DLC may waive the requirement relating to the prescribed time for the application to be lodged pursuant to section 208 of the Act.

We grant the application for a renewal of a manager's certificate pursuant to s.228 of the Act. The certificate will expire on **15 February 2026** unless again renewed.
