


DECISION


DECISION

This is an application by Marcia Ngatai Aroha Graham for a Manager's Certificate. Reports have been received from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and no matters were raised in opposition. Accordingly we shall deal with the matter on the papers.

It is noted that the applicant has little or no experience in the sale of liquor from "On" licence premises, so it is agreed between the applicant and the Tasman District Licensing Committee that the function of Manager will only be undertaken in "Off" licence premises. This limitation may be reviewed by the Tasman District Licensing Committee and removed as soon as suitable experience is obtained by the applicant.

We are satisfied that the applicant meets the criteria as set out in s.222 of the Act and grant the application accordingly. The Manager's Certificate may issue immediately.


