DECISION

The general nature of the event to be held is that of a community festival.

Reports were received from the Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Medical Officer of Health and no matters in opposition were raised. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

In considering the range of matters to which we must have regard, we note that the Tasman District Council Local Alcohol Policy (LAP) contains a discretionary condition in clause 2.3.3 relating to the sale of alcohol pursuant to special licences. Specifically the LAP states:

No school fate, gala or similar event held on school grounds at which the participation of children can be reasonably expected shall allow for the consumption of alcohol on the premises.

We observe from detail provided with the application, that both the alcohol sales and associated facilities such as toilets will be located on the Ngatimoti School grounds. Further, the application is made on behalf of the Ngatimoti School PTA and Information provided with the application identifies that attendees are expected to cover a wide spectrum of ages including children. We conclude that the discretionary condition included in the LAP to be applicable to the Ngatimoti Festival.

In mitigation, the applicant has volunteered the following:

- 1. Only having alcohol sales in a single location;
- 2. The bar will be operated as a restricted area, and persons under the age of 18 shall not be permitted in that restricted area;
- 3. The bar will be housed in a 3 sided marquee and that there will be no promotional signage or specific advertising visible outside of the bar;
- 4. No alcohol will be permitted to be removed from the restricted area:

- 5. The licensed area will be limited to approximately 6 metres by 10 metres and it will be roped off from the other activities at the Festival;
- 6. The hours that the bar operates are the hours shown on the licence, and the event shall otherwise be alcohol free.

The Committee notes that it is not comfortable granting licenses that breach the principle or intent of any relevant provisions of the LAP, but also observes that in this case, there are some mitigating circumstances. Should a similar event be intended for next year, we recommend to the organising committee that the discretionary condition of the LAP detailed above is given careful consideration.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Sections 142 and 143 of the Act, and we grant the applicant the Special Licence sought subject to conditions. A copy of the licence setting out the conditions to which it is subject is attached to this decision.

The licence may issue immediately.
