



DECISION

This is an application by Joshua Snowden Lewis for a renewal of a Manager's Certificate. Reports were received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police, and no matters in opposition were raised. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

The applicant holds the prescribed qualification required by s.218 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, and we are satisfied as to the other matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.227 of the Act.

It is noted that the applicant has little or no experience in the sale of alcohol from on-licence premises, so it is agreed between the applicant and the Tasman District Licensing Committee that the function of Manager will only be undertaken in off-licence premises. This limitation may be reviewed by the Tasman District Licensing Committee and removed as soon as suitable experience is obtained by the applicant.

We grant the application for a renewal of a manager's certificate pursuant to s.228 of the Act. The certificate will expire on **7 July 2020** unless again renewed.
