## ▲ MOTUEKA PUBLIC ART

- The Labyrinth Mosaic (G4)**  
Location: Motueka District Museum, 40 High Street.  
This millennium mosaic was completed in November 2000. It represents the natural and human history of Motueka.
- Carving at Motueka Tasman District Council Service Centre (I4)**  
Represents Motueka's past and present inhabitants and the two main occupations, fishing and agriculture. Created by Te Awhina Marae master Carver John Mutu and his assistant Tim Wraight.
- High Street Streetscaping (G4 - I4)**  
Seats and bins were created by local artists. For example:
  - Surf Board seats - John Wolters
  - Fish - Tim Wraight
  - Totara fencing posts - Richard Fry
  - Mosaic - Lou Moser
  - Old school desk - Stanley Rea
- Kaka Beak (H4)**  
Sculptured by local artist Bruce Mitchell. Created of Takaka hill marble in 2010.
