Whilst the Board supports "a wide range opportunities for responsible camping are available in the rohe". We do not support increased provision for FREE Council provided Responsible Camping sites.

The Board does not support provision for non-self contained vehicles. The Board highlight a key concern over the current inconsistency with standard NZSS465:2001 self containment.
We do not consider that this penalises "non-self" contained vehicles, but recognises the capacity for "self-contained vehicles to camp responsibly.

3. What do you think about our site assessment criteria to help us identify suitable sites for freedom camping (page 14 and 15)?

The Board is interested in some tangible measures around the assessment criteria. It is suggested that the secondary criterion is scored 1-5 rather than yes/no.

Council should also take into consideration the implications of any sites within Liquor Ban areas.
