

MOTUEKA COMMUNITY BOARD

ANNUAL PLAN 2010 – 2011

(Information)

1. Increase the level of Council expenditure in the Motueka ward. Work towards a “balanced – rate – spend” policy for the District indicating that income raised in the ward is spent in the ward.
2. Progress the Motueka central and west planning strategy to the Variation of the Tasman Resource Management Plan stage.
3. Lower Motueka River Stopbank investigation and feasibility study to be progressed (Year 2 of 3). Include Peach Island channel and secondary flow channels issue.
4. Higher priority for Motueka Library – extension or rebuilding.
5. Cycleways, Footpaths, Kerb & Channel, Pram Crossings – increase Council’s level of expenditure on these areas.
6. Major upgrade for the Riwaka to Kaiteriteri Road.
7. Motueka Transportation Study : approve funding and projects arising from this Study, in co-operation with NZTA. E.g. Manoy to Talbot streets link; pedestrian crossings; intersection improvements.
8. Amend the Ten Year Plan / LTCCP resolutions regarding domestic water reticulation in Motueka:-
 - apply the previous Council policy of a gradual extension of reticulation throughout Motueka (10 – 15 year period)
 - prioritise the College Street – Queen Victoria Street – King Edward Street locality as the next area to be reticulated
 - defer the Coastal Tasman pipeline until alternative investigations are completed.
9. Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrade Motueka Oxidation Ponds.
10. Improve stormwater drainage and channels : Poole Street, High Street to Fearon Street.
Maintain the open drains : Lummis, Thorp, Woodland, Queen Victoria.
11. Support Central Government and District Council actions to reduce CO2 emissions.
12. Development of the Port Motueka – North Street – Coastal foreshore area to improve the amenity in this area.
