Please, help us to help our community!!!!

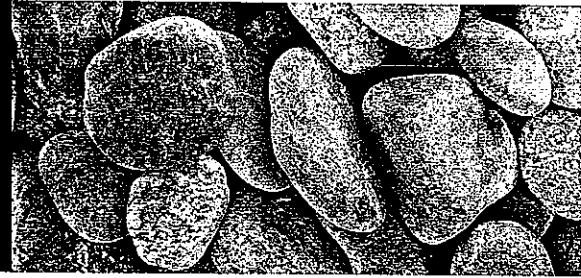

Dear Felicity,

Price to Rebuild Horse Arena

Following your meeting, and discussion on site, with Des Corrie-Johnston we have prepared the following proposal for refurbishing the horse arena on College Street.

The price covers the following work on the 40m by 22m site:

1. Excavate the existing bark and saw dust and remove from the site. The total price allows for CJ Industries to sell this material to recover some of the costs.
2. Excavate unsuitable sub-base material, cart to dump.
3. Form a drainage channel along the Western side.
3. Supply and compact a base course to an average 400mm thick.
4. Finish with a 50mm layer of washed sand.

Our price for this work is \$21,512.00 plus GST.

Hi Felicity

Thank you for the opportunity to price the remedial work on the horse arena.

Concrete & Metals price to carry out the work is \$17,169.00 (excluding gst). Please note that our price includes the following items of work:

Strip the bark to a depth of 450mm from the arena and remove from site.

Area measured at 21m by 40m.

Import place and compact 375mm depth of non crushed gravels ex our yard.

Import place and compact 100mm of ap40 basecourse.

Supply and place 50mm of 6mm sand to the finished surface.

Please note that we have a good supply of the non crushed gravels in our yard at present. Timely notification of our price acceptance would be appreciated so that we can ensure that a sufficient supply of the less expensive non crushed gravels can be set aside for your project. "
