The price covers the following work on the 40m by 22m site:

- 1. Excavate the existing bark and saw dust and remove from the site. The total price allows for CJ Industries to sell this material to recover some of the costs.
- 2. Excavate unsuitable sub-base material, cart to dump.
- 3. Form a drainage channel along the Western side.
- 3. Supply and compact a base course to an average 400mm thick.
- 4. Finish with a 50mm layer of washed sand.
