**SUBJECT:** LGNZ Annual General Meeting, 27 July 2005 -  
Appointment of Delegates

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The Chief Executive is required to advise Local Government New Zealand before 24 June 2005, in writing, the names of one presiding delegate to the AGM, and one or more alternate delegates.

Tasman District Council as a member authority and with a population of between 10 000 and 50 000 is entitled to have no more than three delegates. It is customary to appoint the Mayor as the presiding delegate and nominate any other councillor attending the Conference as the alternate delegate.

- a Appoints Mayor John Hurley as presiding delegate to the Local Government New Zealand Annual General Meeting on 27 July 2005 and;
