SUBJECT: Manager Property Services Report

The boundary adjustment between Diana Mellor and the Waimea West Recreation Reserve is nearing completion and the new titles should issue by the end of August.

Notice of the intention to revoke the status of the Matakītaki Recreation Reserve will be given on Saturday 26 July 2008. Objections close on 28 August 2008. Crs Bryant and Higgins will hear any objections.

Agreement has been reached with Mrs Betty De Liefde for the relocation of the Marahau Fire Station onto her property from the adjoining property. Resource consent has been applied for and while there is not expected to be any difficulty obtaining resource consent for this activity the removal of the building from the existing site to meet the landowner's deadline could be an issue. With goodwill of all parties, I believe that these issues are manageable.

A further meeting to discuss the Golden Bay Civil Defence Emergency Management Response Plan is being held on 1 August at Takaka. The National Tsunami Road Show was held in Nelson on 8 July 2008. I am attending the Minister's National Forum for Civil Defence Emergency Management in Wellington on Thursday 24 July 2008 on behalf of the Chairs of the CEG and CDEMG.
