RICHMOND

Site	Projects for 2010/11	Timeframe
Cambridge Street	Playground (Glenn)	Playground equipment has been installed, associated landscaping being carried out.
Dellside Reserve NBRR	Signage (Steve)	Working with the Native Bird Recovery Richmond group on information signage at walkway entrances to the reserve.
Saxton Field	Avery Toilet Block Changing Rooms (Francie & Glenn)	Plans are being prepared for this project.
Aotea Council Cottages	New cottages (Francie)	The new site is being prepared; specifications are being drawn up to invite expressions of interest for the construction of the new cottages.
Richmond Library	Landscaping (Steve)	Work has commenced on the landscaping around the building.
