

## **Projects : Motueka 2008/2009 (Draft Annual Plan)**

None of the “major projects” listed on page 7 are in Motueka. These range in estimated costs from \$111,700 to \$2,000,000. However, it is expected that Motueka would receive its share (25% minimum) of the area-wide pavement treatment (\$1,260,000) and the Chip Seals (\$1,630,000).
