

Water Shortage Direction

Section 329 of the Resource Management Act 1991

Domestic water use within any water management zone during periods of water rationing in that zone is restricted:

No watering of lawns or decorative gardens is permitted.

Stock drinking water is not restricted.

Stage 1 Rationing which is a 20% cut from authorised weekly usage will **remain** in place from **Monday 09 March 2020** for the holders of consents who are in the following Water Management Zones

**Moutere Western Groundwater,
Lower Confined Aquifer (Affiliated), Hope and Eastern Hills (Affiliated),
Lower Confined Aquifer, Hope and Eastern Hills.
Tapawera, Tadmor, Glen Rae, Baton, Stanley Brook, Wangapeka,
Takaka Surface, Takaka Aquifer, Takaka Marble Aquifer.**

Stage 1 Rationing which is a 20% cut from authorised weekly usage will **commence** from **Monday 09 March 2020** for the holders of consents who are in the following Water Management Zones

Wai-iti, Wai-iti Dam Service

It is important Consent holders are familiar with Resource Consent conditions

The position will be reviewed at the next meeting of the Dry Weather Taskforce on 10 March 2020
