### **OLIVER!**

### 1968 // G // 153 mins

This musical version of Charles Dickens' classic novel stars Mark Lester as Oliver, an orphan who runs away from the Workhouse. On his journey through Victorian London and, by chance, back to his family, he meets a variety of lively characters, some helpful, some more villainous.

### THE TAMING OF THE SHREW

### 1967 // G // 122 mins

The story of taming the 'shrew' in order to win the younger sister has been told in various forms over the years, for example in Kiss Me Kate and 10 Things I Hate About You. In this stunning Franco Zeffirelli film adaptation it is played classically and true to Shakespeare's original play, with truly powerful performances by Elizabeth Taylor and Richard Burton.



### THE DAWN PATROL

1938 // PG // 103 mins

Set during World War I, this moving, sometimes comic, drama examines the futility of war, focusing on a division of the Royal Flying Corps with an appallingly high casualty rate and the impact of this on the behaviour of members of the squadron. Stars Errol Flynn, Basil Rathbone and David Niven.

### **COURAGE OF LASSIE**

1946 // G // 92 mins

Kathie (Elizabeth Taylor) nurses a dog she names Bill (played by Lassie) back to health after he is injured, and they become close friends. They are separated and he is sent to be trained as an army dog, proving himself in battle but becoming shellshocked. Will he find his way back home?

### DR. STRANGELOVE OR: HOW I LEARNED TO STOP WORRYING AND LOVE THE BOMB

1964 // PG // 95 mins

Written and directed by Stanley Kubrick, this Cold War-era dark comedy stars Peter Sellers in three different roles. As the US 'war room' tries to avert the disaster of a nuclear attack begun by a mad US general, we get an insight into the ridiculousness of the strategy of peace through nuclear build up.

1947 // G // 96 mins

A truly wonderful family Christmas movie where realist Doris Walker (Maureen O'Hara) and her daughter Susan (Natalie Wood), who don't believe in fairy tales, are forced to re-examine their beliefs when they meet a man who claims to be the real Santa Claus
